ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, APO.

REURTEL DECEMBER THREE LAST.

AUTHORITY GRANTED TO CANVASS LATIN AMERICAN CONSULATES IN NEW ORLEANS TO DETERMINE IF ANY WERE APPROACHED BY OSWALD.

HANDLE IMMEDIATELY AND SUTEL RESULTS OF INQUIRIES.

NOTE: Effects of Oswald seized by Dallas police revealed notes he made indicating activity in behalf of the Fair Play for Cuba Committee. These notes indicated he had contacted Latin American Consulates in New Orleans to seek their response. Thomas Ehrlich, Department of State, granted approval on 12-4-63 to Liaison Representative O. H. Bartlett for Bureau to canvass Latin American Consulates, New Orleans.
