ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

NOVEMBER TWENTY-TWO, ONE NINE SIX THREE, DALLAS, TEXAS.

ON THIS DATE MR. ROY MILLENSON CONTACTED THE BUREAU AND ADVISED HE IS WASHINGTON REPRESENTATIVE OF THE AMERICAN JEWISH COMMITTEE. HE ADVISED DALLAS REPRESENTATIVES OF THIS ORGANIZATION HAD CONTACTED HIM REQUESTING THAT HE INFORM THIS BUREAU THAT STANLEY MARCUS, OWNER OF NIEMAN-MARCUS DEPARTMENT STORES, HAD INFORMATION THAT QUOTE RADICAL RIGHT UNQUOTE INDIVIDUALS MIGHT HAVE SOMETHING TO DO WITH THE PRESIDENT'S ASSASSINATION. MILLENSON WAS UNABLE TO CLARIFY EXACTLY WHAT MR. MARCUS MEANT AS MILLENSON WAS ONLY RELAYING INFORMATION HE HAD RECEIVED. DALLAS IMMEDIATELY CONTACT STANLEY MARCUS AND INTERVIEW HIM FOR ANY INFORMATION HE MAY HAVE CONCERNING THIS MATTER.
