Perhaps you already know the answers- Call it a woman's intuition, sixth sense or what-ever but, as I say I had to write.

The first picture on the top of the next page really "threw" me- Look carefully at the hat in the center of the picture. Who or what does it remind you of? Now look at the height and build of the man wearing the hat- the wide head and shoulders etc. All of these things remind me of Jack Ruby. Then I asked myself, Why a hat? No one else (except the officers) wore a hat, could this be an identification of some kind? The next question I asked myself was: I wonder just how far from the building in question, was this picture taken. Was this the smaller crowd which was supposed to be at the scene?

The next picture that bothers me is on the top of the next page. Look carefully at Jack Ruby's hat. Now look carefully at his height and build. Now look into the eyes of Oswald. Does he not look pleased, or perhaps that is a look of surprise at seeing someone he knew.
