Enclosed herewith for the Dallas Office is a stencil of an FD-302, dated December 3, 1963, regarding an interview with DON C. MC GLOTHLIN.

DON C. MC GLOTHLIN was interviewed this date. He identified student GEORGE KANTAK, age 16, a Sophomore at William Howard Taft High School, Chicago, Illinois, as the one who asked questions regarding assassinated Presidents during an 11:00 a.m. class November 22, 1963. MC GLOTHLIN stated he could furnish no additional information concerning the student's remarks other than those contained in his letter to the Director. He said he did not suspect the student, GEORGE KANTAK, of having any prior knowledge of the assassination of President KENNEDY.
