SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT

ASAC Winterrowd of the New York Office at 3:30 p. m. today advised that Judge Irving Kaufman had just talked with Assistant Director Malone in the New York Office. Judge Kaufman referred to Senator Dodd and said he understands that the Senator feels there is "more than meets the eye" in the matter of Jack Ruby killing Oswald.

The Judge said he understood that Dodd intends to have someone look into the whole matter. Judge Kaufman also said he understood that the President had sent for Dodd or Dodd was to see the President soon concerning this matter.

ASAC Winterrowd said Judge Kaufman wanted the FBI to know of the above for whatever significance it might have.
