NOTE:

According to [REDACTED] of San Francisco, during March, 1962, he was at party in Denver at which time Nier supposedly said he was going to Mexico and would see a man named Oswald. Nier is Chairman of FPCC chapter in Denver. He has publicly denied knowing Oswald since assassination of President; Oswald is known to have been in Russia in March, 1962; and three other persons present at above-described party do not recall alleged statement concerning Oswald. Nonetheless, to definitely resolve this matter, Denver has requested authority to interview Nier and we concur.
