ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, NOVEMBER TWENTYTWO, SIXTYTHREE, DALLAS, TEXAS.

SERGEANT ESTOPINAL, RECORD ROOM, NOPD, ADVISED THIS DATE THAT HE HAD RECEIVED A TELEPHONE CALL FROM A REPORTER, NAME UNRECALLED, WITH THE FORT WORTH PRESS, WHO STATED THAT HE WAS WRITING A BACKGROUND STORY ON THE OSWALD FAMILY AND WANTED TO KNOW ABOUT A PENDING CASE AGAINST A ROGER RALPH OSWALD, A BROTHER OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD. ESTOPINAL CHECKED AND DETERMINED THAT THE ONLY BROTHER OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD WAS ROBERT LEE OSWALD. STATED THAT THE REPORTER APPEARED TO BE ATTEMPTING TO GET HIM TO SAY THAT ROGER WAS A BROTHER OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

REVIEW OF NOPD RECORDS REFLECT THAT OSWALD, ROGER, RALPH, WHITE MALE, DOB JUNE TWELVE, THIRTYONE, POB HAMMOND, LA. WAS ARRESTED NOVEMBER TWENTYNINE SIXTYTWO AND CHARGED WITH CRIME AGAINST NATURE. DISPOSITION WAS TWO YEARS PROBATION.

REVIEW OF NOPD RECORDS FAILED TO SHOW ANY RECORD IDENTIFIABLE WITH ROBERT LEE OSWALD.
