JACK LEON RUBY, AKA, LEE HARVEY OSWALD - VICTIM, CR.

FOLLOWING TELEGRAM RECEIVED AT BUREAU TODAY, QUOTE ACCORDING TO VERY RECENTLY PUBLISHED NEWSPAPER ITEMS, YOU ARE CLOSING IN ON JACOB RUBENSTEIN. REPORTS PLACED HIM IN THE AMERICANA HOTEL JUST PRIOR TO PRESIDENT KENNEDY-S ADDRESS TO LABOR ORGANIZATIONS.

NEWSPAPER REPORTS ARE TO THE EFFECT THAT RUBENSTEIN HAD CHECKED IN A FEW DAYS PRIOR TO THE PRESIDENT-S ARRIVAL AND THAT THE PRESIDENT-S SECURITY GUARD WAS EXTREMELY HEAVY, THEREUPON RUBENSTEIN CHECKED OUT OF THE AMERICANA AND RETURNED TO DALLAS.

WHEN AND IF THE TEXAS JURY FREES HIM WITHIN A WEEK OR SO HE WILL BE EXONERATED OF JUST ONE MURDER.

WILL THIS MAN STILL BE, IF STILL SUSPECT, AVAILABLE FOR ARREST BY UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT. WIRE ANSWER COLLECT JAY W DEYOUNG FIVE TWO SEVEN YORK AVE NEW YORK TWENTY EIGHT NY. UNQUOTE.
