OSUALD SAID THAT HIS WIFE WAS GOING TO HAVE A BABY AND THAT HE NEEDED TO KEEP A FEW DOLLARS FOR EMERGENCIES. ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER EIGHTEEN, GARNER BELIEVES HE SAW OSWALD SITTING ON HIS PORCH READING, BUT HE CANNOT POSITIVELY AFFIRM THIS.

ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER NINETEEN, AND FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER
TWENTY, GARNER DID NOT WORK AND REMAINED AT THE APARTMENT CUTTING
GRASS ON BOTH DAYS. GARNER STATED THE WOMAN FROM TEXAS PAREN
MRS HICHAEL B. FAINE OF IRVING, TEXAS, PAREN, WAS STAYING WITH THE
OSUALDS ON THESE DATES, AND AT ONE TIME TOLD HIM THAT SHE HAD VISITED
THE FPENCH QUARTER ON A WALKING TOUR ON THE PREVIOUS DAY. GARNER
OBSERVED OSWALD IN HIS APARTMENT ON BOTH OF THESE DATES.


