United States ( Ernment (emorandum DATE: 12/2/63 Assassination of president joun f. Kennedy My memorandum of 11/22/63, set out additional information relating to the sale and distribution of the Western wanufactured 6.5 mm Mannlicher-Carcano amounition used in the assessination. That memorandum was written in response to Mr. Belmont's instructions that every effort be made to trace the ammunition on the possibility. that some of it may be traced into Oswald's hands. The Springfield Office has advised that they have obtained, through contact at the Western Cartridge Corporation, East Alton, Illinois, copies of that Corporation's records relating to the manufacture of this remunition. Western manufactured four million rounds of this ammunition for the United States Marine Corps during States 1954. Attached is a two-page copy of the records of Western relating to the complete manufacture of this order of assumition which was authorized under Covernment contract DA-23-196-ORD-27. The interesting thing about this order is that it is for " ... ... ammunition which does not fit and cannot be fired in any of the USEC weapons. This gives rise to the obvious speculation that it is a contract for emminition placed by CIA with Festern under a USIC cover.
