U.S. OBTAINING INFORMATION FOR A STORY. STONE STATED WHILE IN
WASHINGTON, D. C., SPENT CONSIDERABLE TIME WITH CAB DRIVER WHO
GAVE STORY REGARDING NAVAL PETTY OFFICER THAT WAS VERY CRITICAL
OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY.

STONE OF OPINION THIS INFORMATION VERY VALUABLE AND WISHED TO
BE CONTACTED BY FBI AGENT.
