The Laboratory is requested to make ballistic comparisons, examinations of these casings with the shell cases in instant case to determine if the enclosed cases were fired in the gun used to assassinate President KENNEDY at Dallas on 11/22/63.

The laboratory is requested to return these casings to Dallas when the investigation is completed.
