ADVISED SA J. RAYMOND COGLIN, DECEMBER FIVE LAST THAT HE IS

WORKING FOR A PH.D DEGREE AND KNOWS OF NONE WHO HAVE RELATIVES
IN TEXAS. [ASSISTANT POSTMASTER RICHARD SCHNEEBERGER, MAIN

POST OFFICE, ANN ARBOR, ADVISED SA JOHN L. MC GIRR ON DECEMBER
SIX LAST THAT HE CONTACTED APPROPRIATE PERSONNEL AT MAIN AND
BRANCH POST OFFICES THERE AND NO ONE WITH A GERMAN ACCENT WAS

RECALLED AT THE POST OFFICES. RECORDS, INS, DETROIT, WERE CHECKED
BY SA MELVILLE H. SHANNON AND SA THOMAS J. ROBINSON DECEMBER SIX
LAST AND AUTOSTATIC COPIES OF EIGHTYTHREE FORMS I DASH FIFTYTHREE
PAREN ADDRESS REPORT CARDS ENPAREN FOR GERMAN STUDENTS WERE OB-

TAINED. A REVIEW OF THESE FORMS FAILED TO INDICATE ANY WHICH MAY
REFER TO UNKNOWN WOMAN.

ON DECEMBER SIX LAST MARTIN HAYDEN, EDITOR DETROIT NEWS ADVISED SAC, BERNARD C. BROWN THAT ROBERT LUBECK, FEATURE EDITOR, DETROIT NEWS, HAD RECEIVED A CALL ON DECEMBER FIVE LAST FROM A WOMAN WHO SAID SHE HAD SOME FILMS OF THE ASSASSINATION WHICH WERE BETTER THAN THE ONES IN QUOTE LIFE UNQUOTE MAGAZINE.

ON DECEMBER SEVEN INSTANT ROBERT LUBECK, ONE THREE ONE ONE CADIEUX, GROSSE POINTE, MICHIGAN ADVISED SA LAWRENCE M. COOPER, JR. THAT AT ABOUT FOUR THIRTY PM DECEMBER FIVE LAST HE HAD RECEIVED A TELEPHONE CALL FROM A WOMAN WHO SAID SHE WAS MRS. / BECK FROM LINCOLN PARK, MICHIGAN, A NEWS SUBSCRIBER, BUT REFUSED TO IDENTIFY HERSELF FURTHER. SHE SAID SHE HAD SOME SIXTEEN MILLIMETER COLOR FILM TAKEN OF THE ASSASSINATION WHICH HAD BEEN TAKEN FROM THE OVERPASS AND WHICH WERE BETTER THAN THE QUOTE LIFE UNQUOTE MAGAZINE PICTURES. SHE SAID SHE WOULD BRING THE PICTURES TO THE DETROIT NEWS PERSONALLY.

TO DATE THE FILM HAS NOT BEEN RECEIVED BY EITHER THE DETROIT NEWS OR BY DETROIT OFFICE. LUBECK ADVISED THAT A CHECK OF SUBSCRIBERS TO THAT PAPER HAS NOT REVEALED INDENTITY OF THE CALLER.

INASMUCH AS CALLS WERE RECEIVED BY THIS OFFICE AND DETROIT NEWS AT APPROXIMATELY THE SAME TIME, PAREN CALL AT DETROIT OFFICE RECEIVED FROM WOMEN AT FOUR THIRTY FIVE PM CLOSE PAREN AND ON SAME DATE IT APPEARS CALLS WERE A HOAX AND SUCH FILMS ARE NOT IN EXISTENCE. IT IS ALSO NOTED THAT THE WOMAN CALLER GAVE NEARLY IDENTICAL STORIES BOTH TIMES EXCEPT FOR BACKGROUND AND IDENTIFYING INFORMATION CONCERNING HERSELF. IN BOTH INSTANCES SHE SAID SHE HAD JUST GOTTEN THE FILM, THE MOVIES WERE TAKEN FROM THE OVERPASS AND THE FILM WAS SIXTEEN MILLMETER COLOR. SHE ALSO STRESSED IN EACH CALL THAT THE FILM HAD SHOWED THE PRESIDENT/S WOUND VERY CLEARLY AND WAS MUCH CLEARER THAN THE FILM IN QUOTE LIFE UNQUOTE. IN VIEW OF THE FACT THIS MATTER IS APPARENTLY A HOAX, DETROIT IS CONDUCTING NO FURTHER INVESTIGATION TO IDENTIFY THE UNKNOWN CALLER UACB.
