SUBJECT: LEE HARVEY OSWALD
IS - R

At 12:15 p. m., this date, in my absence, SAC Roy Moore of Little Rock, Arkansas, talked to Supervisor Scatterday.

Moore advised that he had received information from G-2 at Fort Chaffee, Arkansas, that Private First Class [James F. Musto] an Army cook, with Army Serial Number RA[33176748] assigned to Headquarters Company, 31st Engineering Battalion, at Fort Chaffee, had been absent without leave the day before, the day of, and two days after the assassination of the President.

This morning, [Musto] advised his commanding officer that he knew about the President's assassination and was a personal acquaintance of Oswald. Moore advised that [Musto's] Army record indicates he has a history of [REDACTED]

Moore advised that an Agent had reported at Fort Chaffee within thirty minutes of his call and is presently interviewing [Musto] for complete details. Moore stated he would forward a teletype containing complete details of the interview which would pin [Musto] down concerning his statements. Moore stated he would advise Inspector Malley at Dallas directly of the information received concerning [Musto]
