Also enclosed is a note, reportedly in Oswald's handwriting, asking to be enrolled as an associate member and inquiring as to how he can contact the ACLU group in his area. Oswald's address is listed as Post Office Box 6225, Dallas, Texas, and his occupation as photographer. **ACTION BEING TAKEN:** The original evidence submitted with this letter is being furnished to the FBI Laboratory, as we may have future need for further handwriting specimens of Oswald.
