The Attorney General's Office made available a letter received today from Ernest Angell, Chairman of the Board of Directors of the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU), 156 5th Avenue, New York, New York. With this letter Mr. Angell enclosed the original application of Lee H. Oswald for membership in his organization. Also enclosed is a note, reportedly in Oswald's handwriting, asking to be enrolled as an associate member and inquiring as to how he can contact the ACLU group in his area. Oswald's address is listed as Post Office Box 6225, Dallas, Texas, and his occupation as photographer.

ACTION BEING TAKEN:

The original evidence submitted with this letter is being furnished to the FBI Laboratory, as we may have future need for further handwriting specimens of Oswald. The original letter to the Attorney General is being returned to his office with photographic copies of the enclosures, as we have been informed such copies will suffice for handling of the incoming letter in the Department.
