By letter dated 12/3/63 SAC HARRY W. GEIGLEIN, WFO of U. S. Secret Service, furnished results of interview of [redacted] by SA of Secret Service, During this interview, [redacted] advanced his theory concerning captioned assassination.

The following are pertinent ^{portions} of this letter:

[redacted] is a research chemist, employed by the Food and Drug Administration, and located in Room 4152, South Agriculture Building, 14th and Independence Avenue, Washington, D. C. , telephone number DUpont 8-7349. He was interviewed November 27, 1963.

[redacted] stated he was born in Mukden, China, in 1925; that his father was a colonel in the Imperial Russian Army, which was defeated by the Communists, causing his father

to flee to China. [redacted] felt that because of his Russian background, his thinking may possibly be of interest to the Government.

[redacted] states that in his opinion the Communists cannot tolerate any rightist group because this type of group is as persistent and tenacious as the Communists and desire to do away with Communism. He explained that in his opinion the United States could be divided into three groups as follows: the rightists, the moderates, and leftists groups. TEXAS

[redacted] believes LEE HARVEY ^{dead} OSWALD was a dedicated Communist and would never have furnished any information to authorities. He considers it possible the Communists trained OSWALD to be an assassin while OSWALD lived in Russia; that OSWALD not only became an expert rifleman, but a formidable expert. [redacted] conjectured that OSWALD applied for Russian citizenship, was refused and told to return to the United States where he could serve the cause better.

[redacted] believes the Communists consider the "rightist" element in the United States their greatest enemy. As he recalls, about a month ago UN Ambassador STEVENSON was involved in an incident at Dallas, Texas. The responsibility for this incident was attributed to the "rightist" elements in Dallas, Texas. When the Communists learned of President KENNEDY's intention to visit Dallas, OSWALD was told he was the one to assassinate the President. The Communists desired the assassination at Dallas, Texas, at this time for they believed the "rightist" group would be blamed for this act. This would enable the Communists to defeat the "rightists," who would lose all respect in the eyes of the American public. President KENNEDY was merely a "sacrificial lamb."

[redacted] opined that OSWALD went to the movie theatre to locate a Communist who was to give him a Russian passport. He would sit next to one person and when he did not receive a sign or word of recognition, he would move to another. TEXAS

Concerning JACK RUBY, alias RUBENSTEIN, [redacted] believes him to be a person who would do anything for money. The Communists realized this and successfully bribed him to eliminate OSWALD. The Communists desired the death of OSWALD

to guarantee his silence, fearing OSWALD might be suspected to "truth serum."

[REDACTED] added that RUBY probably considers himself a hero and believes he will not receive a life or death sentence.
