KENNEDY Based on my memorandum of November 27, 1963, whereby approval was authorized to perfect arrangements with the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) to utilize their related facilities for the purpose of conducting powder residue examinations of the paraffin casts from Lee Harvey Oswald by neutron activation analysis, Special Agents J. J. O'Connor of the Domestic Intelligence Division and John F. Gallagher of the Laboratory met with representatives of AEC on December 6, 1963. During that meeting Dr. Spofford G. English proposed a technical conference be arranged at the earliest possible date with operational personnel of Oak Ridge National Laboratory. Dr. English telephoned Special Agent Gallagher this morning to advise that Dr. John Swartout, Deputy Director, Oak Ridge National Laboratory and a member of the Neutron Activation Analyses Section of Oak Ridge will be in Washington for a meeting with FBI personnel at 2:00 p.m., on December 11, 1963.
