In accord with my memorandum of November 27, 1963, Deputy Attorney General Katzenbach was recontacted. He was told that while we are doing everything humanly possible to resolve the issues in this case and to prepare a report, we cannot set any specific time as to when this will be completed. He was told that completeness and thoroughness must come first.

Katzenbach said that he completely understood the problem and reiterated his previous expression that he didn't want his inquiry to be interpreted as any kind of pressure. He noted that many new ramifications were being developed on a daily basis which never had been anticipated.
