Enclosed for New York and Dallas is a copy of letter to the Attorney General from Miss A. Nanet Adams dated 12/2/63 which was forwarded to us by the Department.

The letter, which is self-explanatory, indicates Miss Admas has some information concerning the assassination of President Kennedy. Bureau files indicate that the New York Office has had prior experience with Miss Adams and considered her to be mentally unstable; however, in view of the gravity of this particular investigation and the alleged information in Miss Adams possession, New York is instructed to promptly interview Miss Adams, acknowledge receipt of her letter to the Attorney General and determine what information she has concerning the assassination. The results of your inquiry should be promptly submitted to the Bureau and Dallas in a form suitable for dissemination.
