Enclosed for the FBI Laboratory are four (4) 6.5 empty brass shell cases which were furnished the Dallas Office by Mrs. VIRGINIA GOODWIN, 1806 Southwest Third Street, Grand Prairie, Texas, on December 9, 1963.

The FBI Laboratory is requested to make appropriate examination to determine if these cartridges were fired from the gun which was used to assassinate President KENNEDY at Dallas on 11/22/63. These cases need not be returned if the examination does not establish they were fired in this weapon.

COPY & SPECIMENS RETAINED IN LAF FOR LAB ACTION & REPORT

12/12/63

It should be noted they were found by JOHNNIE BOWLING, 1808 Kirby, Carrollton, Texas, in an area west of Carrollton during the period prior to 12/4/63. He in turn gave them to Mrs. GOODWIN's husband.

These cases have not been identified by SA CARTER by any marks or scratches but are identified by a slip in the cellophane envelope that they are being transmitted in by DL File No. 100-10,461, 12/9/63, and the initials AEC.
