LATENT PRINT EXAMINATION

On 12/9/63, we received the letter referred to in memo, Mr. Branigan to Mr. Sullivan, of 12/5/63, entitled "Lee Harvey Oswald, Internal Security - Russia."

As you are aware, this letter was addressed to Lee Harvey Oswald and postmarked La Habana, Cuba, November 28. The letter is dated November 10, 1963.

A second letter was received last night, 12/9/63, which the Laboratory said maybe from the same source. This letter, however, was addressed to Mr. Robert Kennedy.

Both envelopes and letters were examined for latent prints, but none of value were developed.

The specimens were returned to the Laboratory.
