Enclosed are four 6.5 empty brass shell casings which were recovered by the Irving, Texas Police Department at a temporary shooting range located on Highway 183 at Belt Line between 2:00 and 3:00 p.m., on November 29, 1963.

It is requested these shell casings be examined by the Laboratory and comparison be made with the shells which are known to have been fired by the gun that was used to assassinate President KENNEDY at Dallas, Texas, on 11/22/63.

These shells have not been identified individually but are identified by a slip bearing Dallas File No. 100-10461, date 12/11/63, and the initials AEC.

The shells need not be returned to Dallas if they are found not to have been fired in the murder weapon.
