TURNER, Warsaw, North Carolina, has written a letter to the "Atlanta Constitution" which reportedly states "The President got what he deserved; Justice Warren and the Attorney General are next." The telephone call advised appropriate offices of Secret Service had been notified and requested that the Metropolitan Police Department be notified.

Accordingly, the Metropolitan Police Department, Washington, D.C., was notified on December 7, 1963.
