Previous Laboratory report D-436846 AX dated 12/2/63, addressed to your office with copies for San Antonio advised that no conclusion could be reached with respect to the warrants in Qc68 dated 8/9, 8/26, 9/3, 9/13, 9/23, and 10/1 (all in 1963) as they were too indistinct for an adequate examination. Based on the clear photographs submitted and designated as item I, it was possible to positively identify OSWALD, K4 and K5, as the writer of the guestioned endorsements on these warrants.
Also, the same Laboratory report advised that LA Forms 1 B-2 in Qc69 dated 8/27/63, and 9/6/63, were too indistinct for an adequate examination. On the basis of the original forms contained in item II, it was possible to positively identify OSWALD, K4 and K5, as the writer of the questioned signatures on the forms.
