While I would like to be of service, I have always refrained from commenting on material which was not prepared by the FBI or myself. As you may know, President Johnson instructed the FBI to conduct a full investigation into the assassination of President Kennedy and the murder of Lee Harvey Oswald. Our report which contains the results of this investigation has been forwarded to the Attorney General and to the Presidential Commission. The Commission has the responsibility to study all available information and make a finding in this case.
