Enclosed for examination by the Document Section, FBI Laboratory, is the original of a personal history sheet bearing the name "Lee Oswald", made available for such examination by Assistant Principal [REDACTED] HEAD, Warren Easton High School, New Orleans, Louisiana.

On 12/5/63, Assistant Principal [REDACTED] HEAD advised SA JAMES ROYCE PECK that it was his understanding that this personal history sheet was executed by LEE HARVEY OSWALD when he transferred from Beauregard Junior High School to Warren Easton High School, both of New Orleans, Louisiana. HEAD also advised that on this sheet under the question "Do you have any close friends in this school?", apparently an erasure had been made and the word "no" inserted and also noted that two erasures had been made following this. HEAD stated that he could not "make out" the first name but the second name appeared to be "Edward Vobel".

For additional information of the FBI Laboratory a former acquaintance of OSWALD, EDWARD VOEBEL, 4916 Canal Street, New Orleans, Louisiana, has been interviewed relative to his association with OSWALD.
