TWO ZERO BOLTON STREET, BALTIMORE, MARYLAND, TELEPHONICALLY  
ADVISED IC G. VICTOR REUSCHLEIN THAT WHILE READING DECEMBER  
FOURTEENTH ISSUE OF SATURDAY EVENING POST, SHE NOTICED PICTURE  
OF TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY. IN PHOTO WAS MAN WHO HAD  
FEATURES RESEMBLING LEE HARVEY OSWALD TO THE EXTENT SHE BELIEVES  
HE MAY BE OSWALD. PHOTO REPORTEDLY TAKEN AFTER FIRST SHOT WAS  
FIRED AND MAN IN QUESTION IS STANDING IN DOORWAY OF DEPOSITORY  
BUILDING. GRAYSON STATED THAT IF THIS PHOTO COULD BE ENLARGED
