MARKWELL also informed Mrs. CRAMER that he had gone to Mexico City. or Laredo but no reason was given. Mrs. CRAMER stated that MARKWELL was receiving mail under the name of GLENN MART WELL.

Mrs. HAMM was contacted on December 5, 1963, at the Irinity Baptist Church regarding MARKWELL and she stated that she had not met him or even heard of him prior him early in the day he appeared to be above average in he was coming over. She informed MARKWELL at this time that the church would be open to give him food until hever showed.

Mrs. HAM4 was again contacted at approximately 3:30 p.m. December 6, 1993, and she advised that she had not seen or heard from MARKWELL nor has anyone else at the

Mrs. W. E. CHAMEF was contacted by telephone on the evening of December 5, 1963, and she advised that she was suffering from a virus infection and laryngitis, which was very noticeable on the telephone and requested that the interview he postponed until the morning of December 6, 1963.

On December 6, 1963, Mrs. W. E. CRAMER, also known as WILLIE CRAMER, was contacted at her residence 100 Ninth Street, San Antonio. She stated that about November 5, 1963, she met a boy who was residing in an apartment next to the building where her apartment is located. She stated that she understood he first took occupance of his apartment around November 1, 1963. She ASSASS ATION OF IFESTIMAT

advised that after he had introduced himself to her as CLETH MARKWELL be saled Filmission to use her telephone. Sie stated that he used it a number of times and said he was calling this girlfriend but she has no idea of the number he was calling or the identity of the girlfriend. He also informed Mes. CRAMER that he was a Baptist preacher and had come 1: Sta Arto 10 from Dallas, Texas, where he worked as a rist filb entartainer and singer. He stated that he said initially spings. He said that he had served at in the . S. Armed Force and had an honorable discharge. He said that he had been caught by the Communists in Viet Hiem while sending in the U.S. Armed Forces and held prisoner for nearly two years. He claimed that he was firally sple to effect his escape and was returned to the United States and discharged, around July, 1963. MARKWELL : stated that he hallied two Communist guards in an effort to effect his escape from prisoner of war camp. He advised that he was short of funds and Mrs. CRAMER suggested that he contact the American Legion for assistance but he said they were not worth the space they take up. He stated that while en route to San Artonio he had had an accident . and his car was almost completely destroyed and it was presently in a garage lut did not say where. He advised that he has been working for a trucking company but did not say where. He said that some people call him GEORGE MARIWELL, but that his correct name is ROGER MARKWELL. Mrs SLIEF descripted MARKWELL as follows:

Frs. SLIGH stated that in her opinion MARKWEIL left because he could not pay his bill and did not want to embarrass alyone.

Fre. SLICP advised that Mrs. CRAMER is old and at times imagines things. She is kind-hearted but often gets confused on date. Mrs. FLICH advised MARKWELL at no time ever mentioned to her being in or near Russia. and appeared to be very anti-Communist in his belief.

On December (, 1063, Mrs. TEPRY HUFF, 318 Arden Drive, San Antonio, advised that she is the owner of the apartment which EOCER MAPKWELL rented from her on October 31, 1963, at \$35.30 per month. He paid for two weeks and then left on Movember 15, 1963, after telling her that he could not meet the next week's rent. He stated that he had had some bad luck, and had been in an automobile accident and that his car was being repaired and it took all of his money to pay this bill. Mrs. HUFF sivised the address of the apartment where MARKWELL resided is 201 Arden Drive, San Antonio.

A check was made with the Selvation Army in San Antonio on December 6, 1963, and the manager, WALTER MARTIN, advised that they have had no one by the name of MARKWEIL, MARTWELL, or BROCKWELL during the month of November, 1963, or up through December 6, 1963.

A check was made at the San Antonio Police Department, Identification Section, and the San Antonio

On December 6, 1963, Mrs. STAZIE TAFOLIA, Texas Employment Commission, 406 N.
