Dear Mrs. Schimek:

Your letter of December 5th has been received, and I want to thank you for giving me the benefit of your observations and comments.

As you may know, President Johnson instructed the FBI to conduct a full investigation into the assassination of President Kennedy and the murder of Lee Harvey Oswald, and I can assure you every ramification of this matter has been carefully considered. Our report which contains the results of this investigation has been forwarded to the Attorney General and to the Presidential Commission. We have not made its contents public inasmuch as the Commission has been charged with the responsibility to make a finding in this case.
