The official time of arrival at Parkland Memorial Hospital, Dallas, Texas, for the President was 12:38 P.M. and the official time of death was 1:00 P.M., November 22, 1963.

The President's body was then undressed by the above listed nurses and transforred to a casket. Clothes and effects were given by nurse to Secret Service Agents. Nurse stated that she had removed the watch from the President's left wrist and placed it in her pocket. This was done because the President was to have received an intravenous transfusion. She said she forgot the watch until the President's body had left the hospital, but that she had immediately presented the watch to Mr. This watch was recovered from Mr. So on November 26, 1963, by SA Warner and given to SAIC Sorrels on the same date.

The stretcher on which the President was treated and died was cleaned by Nurse the president before it was removed from the emergency Room #1. Hiss the was positive that nothing remained on the stretcher except medical instruments used in the treatment of the President.
