Mr. O. P. BOBBITT, 3405 Barranca Circle, Austin, Texas, has advised that [REDACTED] Houston, Texas, has attempted to contact Mrs. O. P. BOBBITT concerning the assassination of President KENNEDY.

Mr. BOBBITT did not permit [REDACTED] to talk to Mrs. BOBBITT, the latter who is a sister of President LYNDON B. JOHNSON. Mr. BOBBITT requested that an Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation interview [REDACTED] concerning information she desired to furnish.

[REDACTED] was interviewed by an FBI Agent at the Continental Trailways Bus Depot in Austin, Texas, at which time she advised that she traveled to Austin, Texas, to furnish information relative to the assassination of President KENNEDY.

[REDACTED] was obviously emotionally disturbed and related an incoherent story. She stated she has been living under a "persecution situation" for the last ten years. She stated that one of [REDACTED] TED O. LAWS, 5609 Dorbrandt, Houston, Texas, has some connection with the assassination of KENNEDY. She stated that she has been followed by an attorney, LAWRENCE ARIN, and that she was in the FBI headquarters in Houston, Texas, for the purpose of relating her story at which time she saw ARIN. She stated that everywhere she goes she finds ARIN is following her. She stated she has a son, [REDACTED] who is serving a sentence at Huntsville, Texas, for murder and that he was framed and was not involved in a murder. She believes that her son's prosecution and her persecution could be traced back to TED LAWS who has connections in Dallas.

She stated HICKEY CRAVENS is a truck driver who obtained a job with the Braswell Truck Lines in Houston driving trucks to Dallas and she found that he, CRAVENS, is a friend of LAWS.

She also informed that one SIGMUND BYRD, a former newspaper reporter for the Houston Chronicle is a party of the persecution group in Houston. Texas

[redacted] described TED O. LAWS as being 53 years old, 6' tall, blond hair, and owns a farm at Bellevue, Texas.
