For the information of the Bureau and Dallas, the "New York Herald Tribune" newspaper dated 1/15/64, page 7, column 1, contained an article entitled "Oswald's nother Hires Lane". This article stated that on 1/14/64, Hrs. MARGUERITE C. OSWALD, mother of accused assassin LEE HARVEY OSWALD, announced she had hired subject to represent her slain son before the Warren Commission and in the investigation of the murder of President KENNEDY,

According to this article, Ers. OSWALD stated she had been in telephonic contact with LANE and he had arrived in Fort Worth, Texas, the previous weekend. She based her action on articles IAHE had written stating her son could not have killed President KENNEDY. It was pointed out that IANE had accepted the case although Mrs. OSWALD stated she had no funds with which to pay him.
