At me beginning of the year (1964) I wrote to you concerning the photograph of what appeared to be the figure of a man with a gun in his hand. The photograph appeared in anational magazine and had been taken a few minutes after the assassination of John F. Kennedy. In my letter, I asked if an explanation had been found for this photograph. Shortly after this, a gentleman with the FBI came to my home and asked the whereshouts of this photograph. This semtleman also told me he had been sent by you "to enswer all your questions." However, after seeing the photograph in the national magazine (and, I admit I was suprised that the FFI with its hundreds of agents of mail by contain full time on the assassination details did not enough to see this photograph for themselves), the agent left my house althout answering my questions as he claimed he had been sent to do to you.

From the standpoint of his avewed intent, was the visit abortive I to not know. I to how that I am still waiting for an explanation of that approved to be the photograph of a man on a cooftop carrying a gun. Was it a man? Was it a gun? Was it a rooftop? Is there enyone in the United States who can give me a straight answer to a straight question? Or, for some reason, are we all too afraid of one another?
