ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, 11/22/63, Dallas, Texas.

On March 16, 1964 (Mr. PAT CARDER, Manager, Cuboid Department, Womer Shoes, first floor, Joske's Department Store, San Antonio, Texas,) advised that at about 8:00 p.m. Notember 21, 1963, he was demonstrating his product at Wolks <u>Inspiritment Store</u>, Dallas, Texas,) and sold a set of Burns Cubbid a Arch Supports to 2 (Mrs. GORMAN.)

(Mrs. GORMAN, a women age 50-55,) stated that she knew all of the political factions in Ballas and made the statement that the people engaged in Dallas city politics were a bunch of left-wings. She stated that she could tell things that would "curl your hair". From her conversation she inferred that Communists were in the city government of Dallas. Mr. CARDER stated she made the statement "all hell is going to break loose here tomorrow". She did not mention President KENNEDY or the parade that was to be held at Dallas on November 22, the next day. (She indicated that her husband was in the brokerage business) but did not indicate what type.
