Dear Mr. Rankin:

On April 20, 1964, Mr. Melvin Eisenberg of your staff delivered to a representative of the FBI Laboratory a sample of gummed paper tape and a sample of brown wrapping paper which were reportedly obtained from Mrs. Ruth Paine, Marine Oswald's landlady, for comparison with the paper found on the sixth floor of the Texas School Book Depository building (Commission Exhibit 142).

The sample of gummed paper tape and the sample of brown wrapping paper obtained from Mrs. Paine was designated as Exhibit B-208 in this case. As a result of a comparison of the paper and tape in Exhibit B-208 with the paper and tape used to make the paper tag, Commission Exhibit 142, it was concluded that the paper and tape in Exhibit B-208 were different from the paper and tape in Commission Exhibit 142 and could not have come from the same original source.

Pursuant to the request of Mr. Eisenberg, Exhibit B-208 is being retained in the files of this Bureau.
