Reference is made to my letter dated January 21, 1964, which enclosed two copies of the report of Special Agent Robert P. Gemberling dated December 18, 1963, at Dallas, Texas, captioned, "Assassination of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy, November 22, 1963, Dallas, Texas." This report contained the results of investigation conducted by this Bureau relative to allegations against persons other than Lee Harvey Oswald since the assassination of President Kennedy. This report also set forth the remarks allegedly made by various persons relative to their feelings concerning President Kennedy, other officials and the policies of the administration.
