Lee Rankin, General Counsel, President's Commission, Mr. Rankin stated that he was personally going to Dallas to supervise the project that will be carried out there on the coming weekend and advised Malley that Inspector Tom Kelley had been requested to go to Dallas and he would likewise like to have Malley present in Dallas during the handling of this project.
