Enclosed for Albany and Dallas are copies of a self-explanatory communication turned over to this Bureau by U. S. Secret Service Headquarters on 5-14-64.

In addition to Mrs. Campbell's letter to President Johnson, U. S. Secret Service advised this individual telephonically contacted the White House on 5-6-64 at which time she was told to contact the FBI.

No information identifiable with Mrs. Georgia/Campbell or Mrs. Georgia Ventura could be located in Bureau files.

In view of the allegation that Mrs. Campbell has "startling information" concerning the assassination, Mrs. Campbell should be thoroughly interviewed and the results appropriately reported to Dallas in insert form for subsequent dissemination to the President's Commission.

This matter must be expedited as it is possible the President's Commission may conclude its inquiries into the assassination at an early date. Enclosures (2)
