Malley to Rosen 6/8/64 captioned "Assassination of the President" JRM:mpd indicates Howard Willens of the Commission staff advised the Commission had received a telephone call from [Partridge] of Akron, Ohio, indicating he had information of value concerning the assassination. Willens requested we interview [Partridge] and furnish results to the Commission. Cleveland instructed to promptly interview [Partridge] and furnish results to the Bureau in LHM for dissemination.
