Re Bureau airtel to Richmond, 6/10/64, reflecting information concerning statement by FRED NORRIS.

FRED NORRIS has been interviewed at Dallas, Texas, in which he denies making any statement to the effect, "I hope it happens before January." During interview, NORRIS stated he and brother-in-law, ARTHUR E. SWEENEY, have always been on opposite sides of the political scenes and have often engaged in heated political arguments.

This interview will be reported in a subsequent report in captioned matter, along with information received from other offices in insert form. Any offices receiving this communication who have not submitted results of investigation to Dallas in connection with this particular allegation should immediately submit 25 copies of such results.
