their findings will be colored to suit politicians. He said this "conspiracy" is composed of individuals unknown to him and he believes they are communist who communicate with him by "conditional reflex." He stated that when something is to occur either to him or someone important these unknown persons turn on a light in a neighbors garage. After the occurrence has taken place the lights go out.

He claims previus employment Lewis Research Center and was discharged because he was considered a security risk and was dangerous to other employees and government property.

He stated that he had written to Presidents ELSENHOWER and JOHNSON and numerous members of Congress. He admits receiving treatment as a patient at the Cleveland Psychiatric Institute, Clevelnd, Ohio. The records of this institute indicates PAROBEK was admitted on May 8, 1961, went home of his own accord on 6/23/61 and discharged on 8/13/62. The condition for which he was treated was not revealed.

On 4/19/63, PAROBEK was interviewed at the Cleveland Office of the FBI for a position of Electronic Mainteance **IECOLIFICAM**. At that time he indicated he had been confined to the Ohio State Psychiatric Institute, Cleveland, Ohio, from April to June, 1961. He indicated he suffered from "conditional reflex" and that he was constantly being followed. He appears unstable but harmless and his name is carried in the "Psycho Box" of the Cleveland Office.
