The Commission by letter 3-26-64, requested we endeavor to identify the individuals who left latent prints on the efere-mentioned cartons. This comparison was limited in accordance with the Commission's instructions to those ISDD employees on whom we could locate prints. Some 16 individuals were initially checked and the results furnished to the Couriesion by letter 3-30-64. The most recent request 6-9-64, reiterates this request but specifies that "all appropriate methods, including if recessary, the taking of new fingerprints" be used.

The most logical method of complying with the

Commissions request, was to take major case prints of all employees, insanch as both latent palm and fingerprints are involved. However, in view of the objections of Mr. Truly, it is felt our efforts should be limited as set out above unless a specific request to the contrary is received. This matter will be closely followed.
