Thank you for your letter of March 30, informing me that a copy of my letter concerning my son Lee was forwarded to the American Embassy at Moscow. However, I feel that ample time has passed and that I should have some sort of report. Please follow up my request.

I would also like to know if Lee had signed the necessary papers renouncing his citizenship or is he still a citizen of the United States. The newspaper's at the time stated that he was asked to think it over until he was sure a Soviet citizenship would be tendered. The Russians refused his request, stating that he could remain in their country as a "resident alien".
