

I, the Honorable Counsel, do hereby request that my beloved United States citizenship be restored.

I applied in person at the consulate office of the United States Embassy, Moscow, on Oct 31st, for the purpose of requesting the former powers to this effect. This last night I was refused at that time.

I wish to protest against this action, and against the conduct of the officials of the United States, counsel, since who is acting on behalf of its United States government.

My application, requesting that I be considered for citizenship in the Soviet Union is now pending before the Supreme Soviet of the USSR.
In the event of acceptance, I will request my government to lodge a formal protest regarding this incident.
