the country at any time. But

marina's entrance visa into the  
U.S. These are granted by the

assured me they are getting all the papers together (they are quite nice) and certified accepted.

How are things at your end? I heard over the voice of American that they released Powers to U.S. my plane fellow. That they now know where you are I suppose. We seemed to be a nice, bright american-type fellow, when I saw him in Moscow.

You wouldn't have any clippings from the Nov. 1958 newspaper of St. Louis, would you?

I am trying very to get interested in just what they did say about me and my flight here.

The information might come in handy when I get back. I would hate to come back completely unprepared.

The American Embassy in Moscow has offered us a loan to pay for the price of the airline

dictated, so we have nothing to  
worry about temporary aircrash  
site.

Have you heard from P.M. T.  
all, what's he doing now? still in  
the air force do you know?  
Well, at gulf, tell all  
for now.

P.S. I received a letter from you  
dated Jan. 3. I did not get it until  
Feb. 5. The censors are so stupid  
over here it sometimes takes them  
a month to censor a letter before  
letting it through.

Maria and June are both


Dorothy will remain left the hospital

house?


I got a letter from the Marine




Dear Client:
