The chances of our coming  
to the States are very good.  
As I already told you, we received  
the Soviet exit visas. I can leave  
the country at any time. But  
there are still formalities concerning  
maria's entrance visa into the  
U.S. These are granted by the  
U.S. government, and they have

assured me they are getting all the papers together (they are quite vast) and certified accepted.

How are things at your end? I heard over the voice of America that they released Powers to the spy plane fellow. That's big news where you are I suppose. He seemed to be a nice, bright American-type fellow, when I saw him in Moscow.

You wouldn't have any clippings from the Nov. 1958 newspaper of Mt. North, would you?

I am beginning to get interested in just what they did say about me and my trip here.

The information might come in handy when I get back. I would hate to come back completely unprepared.

The American Embassy in Moscow has offered us a loan to pay for the price of the airline

helped, so we don't need to

Have you heard from Picot  
all, what's he doing now? still in  
the air force do you know?

Well, I guess that's all  
for now.

P.S. I received a letter from you  
dated Jan. 3. I did not get it until  
Feb. 5. The censors are so stupid  
over here it sometimes takes them  
a month to censor a letter before  
letting it through.

stay together. Am quite sure.

to the family.

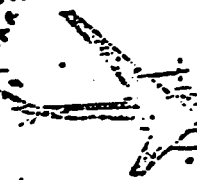

after 3 months and they could contact  
me through your address.

Now that winter is gone,  
I really don't want to leave until  
the beginning of fall since the



spring and summer here are so nice.  
Mama and June are all right.  
June already weighs 11 lbs or so.  
she's real cute.  
Mama sends her "hello" to the  
family. Hope about all for now.

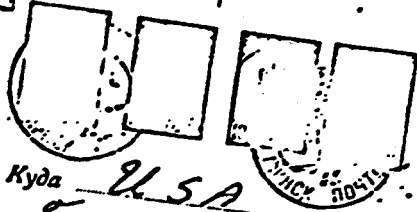

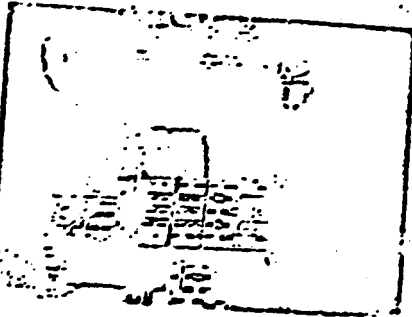

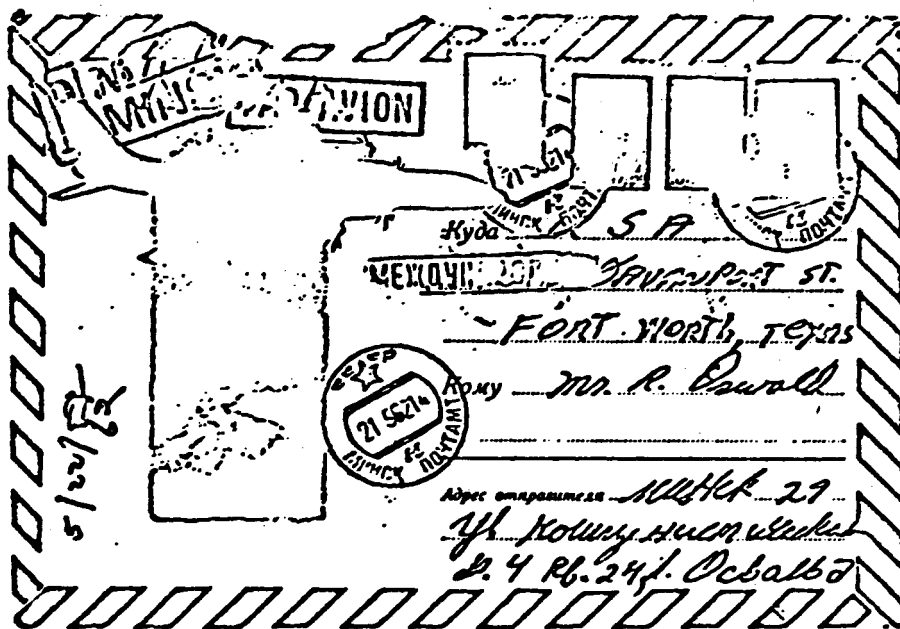
