Re Dallas airtel to Bureau, 5/22/64, enclosing
letterhead memorandum reflecting results of certain investi-
gation requested by President's Commission letter dated
5/13/64, regarding the photograph of the house of Major
General EDWIN A. WALKER. *Dallas, Texas*

In connection with such investigation, WALKER was
out of the city during the week of 5/18/64, and was not in-
terviewed in connection with the investigation.

Furthermore, WALKER is a very controversial figure
and any contact with him would undoubtedly cause him to im-
mediately alert the press media concerning the nature of the
inquiries.

Furthermore, it is pointed out that WALKER maintains
armed guards in the vicinity of his residence from time to
time.

It is believed that the Commission's request has
been adequately covered and UNCB, Major General EDWIN A.
WALKER will not be contacted.
