Result of examination:

The envelope in Q585 measures approximately 3½ inches
by 6½ inches. It contains no watermark or indented writing.
The address on the envelope is hand printed in a black ball-point
ink.

The typed letter in Q585 was prepared on a sheet of
paper measuring approximately 8 inches by 10½ inches. It contains
no watermark or other significant features to indicate the source
of the paper. The typewriting on the letter in Q585 cannot be
definitely classified but does resemble most closely an Olympia
elite style of type spaced twelve letters per inch.

The typewriting and hand printing in Q585 were not
identified in the Anonymous Letter File. Appropriate photographs
will be added.

The submitted evidence is retained.
