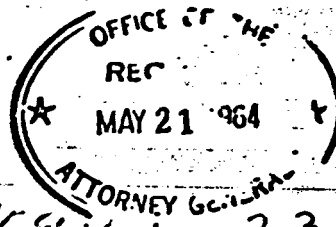
I am not interested in talking to some "run of the mill" person and I have been patient to this point. If my knowledge is not explored, we can file it under the heading of "Nothing Gained".
